Elgin Parks and Recreation Department Cancels Classes and Programming



Elgin Parks and Recreation Department Cancels All Programming through March 29; Some Facilities Remain Open

As part of the City of Elgin's ongoing efforts to slow the spread of coronavirus, The Elgin Parks and Recreation Department has cancelled all classes and programs beginning Saturday, March 14. This includes classes and programs at the Edward Schock Centre of Elgin, the Eastside Recreation Center and Hawthorne Hill Nature Center. Classes and programs are tentatively set to resume on Monday, March 30, 2020, but staff will continue evaluating needs during this rapidly changing environment.

Parks and Recreation staff will work with patrons on rescheduling and other issues with accommodations.

Facilities Open

The Edward Schock Centre of Elgin, the Eastside Recreation Center and Hawthorne Hill Nature Center are open to the public.

The Edward Schock Centre of Elgin and the Eastside Recreation Center will remain open with limited amenities including the fitness centers, lap swim and private rentals with under 250 people, but that is subject to change at staff's discretion.

The Bowes Creek Country Club and Highlands of Elgin golf courses remain open, weather dependent and subject to change at staff's discretion.

Facilities Closed

The Hawthorne Hill Nature Center building is closed. Trails remain open from dawn until dusk.
